Tri-City Bowling Association Seniors Handicap Singles Tournament Rules 2016 – 2017

1. All members of the Tri-City USBC Bowling Association are eligible to enter. Non-members living within the jurisdiction of this association are also eligible. The Tri-City jurisdiction covers Cudahy, South Milwaukee and Oak Creek, Wisconsin. Non-certified bowlers may purchase a certification by paying \$ 20.00 and will receive a USBC certification card (Rule 300c) good through July 31, 2017. If certified nationally through another association, the Local Only certification fee is \$ 10.00.
2. All bowlers must be fifty-five years or older before July 31, 2017.
3. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and will be handicapped. Handicap will be based on a 225 scratch at 90%. No deduction for averages over 225.
4. Entrants shall use their highest USBC (any association) certified league average of 21 games or more from the previous season, UNLESS their current average is 15 or more pins above that average with 12 or more games at time of bowling. If no average from last season is available, the current seasons certified average of 12 games or more must be used. All others bowl scratch. All entrants must report prior tournament average adjustments and re-rates before bowling (Rule 319e). A letter will be sent to notify those bowler's with an adjusted average prior to bowling in the tournament (time permitting).
5. It shall be bowler's responsibility to verify that their average is correct. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. Prize winnings will be based on submitted average if it is higher.
6. USBC Rule 319d regarding the reporting of prior tournament shall be waived.
7. The tournament format will be three (3) games on the same pair of lanes.
8. All prize fees will be returned 100% plus sponsor's donation (prize ratio will be at least 1 in 4 Rule 308c).
9. All bowling will begin as scheduled. Any bowler arriving late will receive zero (0) for each frame missed and their score counting from the frame bowled.
10. An entry blank must be completed before participants bowl. Advance reservations requested. Advance payment appreciated.
11. Entries close at the scheduled time to bowl. Walk-ins are welcome.
12. All decisions of the Tournament Management are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
13. Refer to the entry form for the tournament fee and prizes. All fees must be paid prior to bowling.
