Tri-City USBC Bowling Association Scratch Match Game Singles Tournament Rules 2016 – 2017

1. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress. All USBC rules will be observed. All bowlers will be asked to present their USBC certification cards.
2. Only Tri-City certified bowlers are eligible, and must have 21+ games in the 2015-16 season, or 12+ games in the 2016-17 season in a certified Tri-City USBC BA League.
3. All bowling will be scratch. No handicap will be given.
4. Initial qualifying will be three (3) games on three (3) pairs of lanes. The top twelve (12) scores will immediately advance to match play. If a tie occurs for any position, the bowler with the highest game during qualifying will be the higher seed. Bowlers will be seeded as shown below. Initial qualifying may be subject to change based on Tournament Director Discretion.
5. Match play will be the best two (2) of three (3) on the same pair of lanes until the finals.
6. All prize fees will be returned 100% with a prize ratio of at least 1 in 4 entries (Rule 308). Based on the number of entries, the prize money may be paid to more than the top twelve places as a consolation prize.
7. In the event of a tie game during match play, a three (3) frame roll-off (8th, 9th and 10th frames) will take place and will be repeated until a winner is determined.
8. All bowling will begin as scheduled. Bowlers will receive zero (0) for all missed frames.
9. No substitutes will be allowed. Any bowler withdrawing will receive zero (0) for each frame not bowled.
10. USBC Rule 319d (reporting of prize winnings) does not apply. USBC Rule 319e (average adjustment for entry) will be waived.
11. All decisions of the tournament management are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
12. Entries close at the scheduled starting time of the tournament. Walk-ins are welcome.

The Top four seed's receive a bye on the first round.
Because we introduced one more round, we have three games for qualifying.
