Tri-City USBC Bowling Association Senior/Non-Senior Handicap Doubles Tournament Rules 2016- 2017

1. All members of the Tri-City USBC Bowling Association are eligible to enter.
Participants must bowl in a Tri-City USBC Certified league for the 2015-16 or 2016-17 season. The Tri-City jurisdiction covers Cudahy, South Milwaukee and Oak Creek, Wisconsin.
2. One bowler must be 55 years or older and one 54 years or younger by July 31, 2017.
3. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and will be handicapped. Team handicap will be based on a 450 scratch at 90%. No deduction for averages over 450.
4. Entrants shall use their highest USBC (any association) certified league average of 21 games or more from the previous season, UNLESS their current average with 21 games or more is 15 or more pins over the previous year at time of bowling (Rule 319a2). If no average from last season, the current seasons certified average at the time of bowling with 21 games or more must be used. All others bowl scratch. All entrants must report prior tournament average adjustments or re-rates before bowling (Rule 319e). In addition to re-rate averages, it shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify that their average is correct. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. Prize winnings will be based on submitted average if it is higher.
5. Multiple entries will be allowed under the following circumstances:
 - a) First time entrants will be assigned before multiple entrants.
 - b) Only the highest position attained will be paid with the same partner but may cash as often as partners are changed (Rule 315b).
6. USBC Rule 319d regarding the reporting of prior tournament winnings shall be waived.
7. The tournament format will be three (3) games on the same pair of lanes.
8. All prize fees will be returned 100% plus sponsor's donation (prize ratio at least 1 in 3 Rule 308c).
9. All bowling will begin as scheduled. Any bowler arriving late will receive zero (0) for each frame missed and their score counting from the frame bowled.
10. An entry blank must be completed before participants bowl. Advance reservations requested - Advance Payment Appreciated. This cuts the time at the registration table.
11. Entries close at the scheduled time to bowl. Walk-ins are welcome.
12. All decisions of the Tournament Management are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
13. Refer to the entry form for the tournament fee and prizes. All fees must be paid prior to bowling.
